1996 BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP & NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCE



BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT - UNCG 79, LIBERTY 53

- UNCG secured its first-ever NCAA Division I Tournament appearance with a 79-53 victory over hosting Liberty in the 1996 Big South Tournament Championship.
- Scott Hartzell was named Big South Tournament Most Valuable Player as he scored 14 points in the final game to become the all-time leading scorer at UNCG.
- UNCG held Liberty to 31 percent shooting in the second half and made 25-of-33 free throws to cruise to the 26-point victory in front of 8,173 fans.
- Eric Cuthrell was named to the Big South All-Tournament team after scoring 15 points while grabbing 13 rebounds.
- The Spartans were awarded the 15th seed in the Southeast Regional and played second-seeded and No. 7 Cincinnati in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Orlando, Fla.

UNCG battled No. 7-ranked Cincinnati to the wire in its first NCAA Division I Tournament appearance before falling 66-61.

The Spartans, seeded No. 15 in the Southeast Regional, trailed by 14 points, 46-32, with 16:36 left in the second half. The Bearcats' Darnell Burton hit a three-pointer for a 13-point edge, 61-48, with just 4:14 remaining in regulation.

But UNCG (20-10) rallied on a 7-0 run triggered by Scott Hartzell's tray at the 3:44 mark, and were within 61-55 with 1:20 to go. Eric Cuthrell's free throw with 8.8 remaining pulled UNCG as close as it would get, 65-61.

UNCG outrebounded the Bearcats 39-38 including 20-13 on the offensive boards.

The Bearcats were Conference USA champions and Danny Fortson was Player of the Year in that league.

2001 SoCon Tournament Championship & NCAA Tournament Appearance



SoCon Tournament - UNCG 67, Chattanooga 66

- UNCG secured its first-ever Southern Conference Tournament championship and its second NCAA Division I NCAA Tournament appearance with a 67-66 victory over Chattanooga in Greenville, S.C.
- David Schuck banked in the game-winning basket at the buzzer to send the Spartans to victory at the Bi-Lo Center.
- Schuck and Courtney Eldridge were named to the All-SoCon Tournament First Team while Jay Joseph was named to the All-SoCon Tournament Second Team.
- Schuck finished the game with 21 points and nine rebounds as he was 9-of-17 from the field.
- Ronnie Taylor added 14 points while Joseph and Nathan Jameson each chipped in 10 points.
- The Spartans were awarded the 16th seed and travelled to San Diego, Calif., against top-seeded Stanford in the first round.

Seven-foot center Jason Collins scored 20 of his game-high 25 points in the first half to help Stanford to an 89-60 win over UNCG in the first round of the NCAA West Regional.

UNCG, which finished 19-12, was led by David Schuck's 16 points, Ronnie Taylor's 15, Courtney Eldridge's 13 and Jay Joseph's 12. Joseph's dozen were all on three-pointers in the opening half.

The Cardinal finished the first half on an 11-2 run to break the game open and lead 48-27 at intermission. Collins hit six of nine shots from the floor and hit all seven free-throw attempts in the first 20 minutes of play.

Stanford, the top seed in the Regional, improved to 29-2 on the season.
