DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO GRANDOVER RESORT

Arriving from the North

- Following Interstate 85 South, towards Charlotte
- Exit at #122A and turn RIGHT onto Groometown Road
- Turn LEFT at the first stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- The Resort entrance is on the right at 1.3 miles

Arriving from the South

- Follow Interstate 85 North, towards Greensboro
- Exit at #119 and turn LEFT onto Groometown Road
- Turn LEFT at the Second Stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- The Resort entrance is on the right at 1.3 miles

Arriving from the East

- Follow Interstate 40 West, into Greensboro
- Stay left onto Interstate 85 South, towards Charlotte
- Exit on #122 A and turn RIGHT onto Groometown Road
- Turn LEFT at the first stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- The Resort entrance is on the right at 1.3 miles

Arriving from the West

- Follow Interstate 40 East into Greensboro
- You will see (2) 85 signs, One 85 South and One 85 North
- Take first Exit which is 85 South Exit Road will then split Bear RIGHT to take Groometown Road Exit
- Turn RIGHT onto Groometown Road
- Turn LEFT at the first stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- The Resort entrance is on the right at 1.3 miles

Directions to Grandover from PTI Airport:

- Enter onto East Bryan Blvd by turning RIGHT
- Take the Winston Salem Exit off of Bryan Blvd staying on I-73 East to Exit #97B (Greensboro / Charlotte / High Point)
- Merge RIGHT to Groometown Road / Grandover Parkway Exit
- Turn RIGHT onto Groometown Road
- Turn LEFT at the first stoplight onto Grandover Parkway
- The Resort's entrance is on the right at 1.3 miles

SCORING

Scorecards shall be kept in accordance with Rule 6-6 of the USGA's "Scoring in Stroke Play." The scorecard will be deemed returned to the golf committee when the player or coach places it in the scoring box. There will be a scoring area in the main dining room of the clubhouse. Players are required to turn in their scores with their group prior to interacting with anyone other than the designated coaches.

SHUTTLE SERVICE WITH GRANDOVER

The teams who fly in PTI / Greensboro will be provided with a free shuttle service to get you to Grandover and back to the airport. We will need your flight information when it is available. All meals will be at Grandover so a van is not required.

SPECTATORS / CARTS

Spectators must remain on the cart paths or in the rough and approximately 15 yards from the players at all times (including practice areas). There may be no communication between players and spectators that could be deemed advice of any nature for the duration of play. Please have all ringers on electronic devices turned off. Spectator carts will only be available for people with handicap credentials.

FRIDAY NIGHT - Dining Guide

Grandover has wonderful restaurants, *Di Valletta and Café Espresso*, which you can dine at. For the teams who have vans there are many restaurants within a 10 minute drive. The front desk will have the directions to all of them.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Bridgestone Golf Collegiate will be a 54-hole competition, 13 teams. If conditions dictate a change in format, only the Rules Committee can make a decision to shorten the tournament.

There will be no playoffs or tiebreakers. We will have Co-Champions if required.
